Please emphasize measurement of individual growth rather than measurement of relative performance among students.

Please reduce the number of standardized tests, administered to Ohio's students, to the federal requirements listed in ESSA, only. Turn areas not subject to ESSA requirements over to local control.

Please restructure the state report card system to provide more useful information than simply "A through F."

While listening is important, it is ultimately of little value if it does not turn into participation.
