

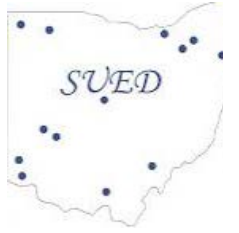

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Who we are

- SUED is an association of education deans from Ohio’s 13 public Colleges of Education

- SUED’s mission:

To ensure the highest quality candidates are prepared for employment in schools, agencies, and other professional settings



Our Outcomes

- Overall 98% pass rate on required Ohio Assessment of Professional Knowledge
- 24.0 ACT mean composite score
 - Ohio mean is 22, national mean is 20.8
- More than 2400 Initial Licensure Completers in 2016
- All Ohio's public teacher prep programs are accredited by NCATE/CAEP



Our Programs

- Meet the needs of P-12 students
- Prepare future educators to be successful in diverse P-12 schools
- Facilitate entry into the education profession
- Provide continuing education and resources

 - 2+2 agreements with community colleges

Quality Educator Preparation

- Research that shows effectiveness
 - Universal Prevention and Pre-service Teachers
 - To increase teachers' efficacy in instructional strategies, student engagement, and classroom management
 - Research based universal prevention strategy using the PAX Good Behavior Game
- Innovations
 - Co-Planning/Co-Teaching model
 - A collaborative student teaching model
 - Improves scores of the P-12 children more than the teacher alone or traditional teaching



Partnerships

 - Mutually beneficial
 - Professional Development-Ohio's universities have much to offer
 - Reading
 - STEM
 - Addressing opiate epidemic
