



JOINT EDUCATION OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

Chair Manning called upon State Superintendent Paolo DeMaria to present on the Ohio Improvement Process to the committee. Superintendent DeMaria answered questions from the committee.

Chair Manning asked about successes schools have had with connecting with family members of students.

Chair Manning asked about principal training, evaluations, and a possible shortage of principals.

Senator Sykes asked, in light of the fact that we already know so much about school improvement, what can Ohio do to make a difference.


Chair Manning asked what ODE does to keep schools out of Academic Distress Commission.


Senator Lehner pointed out that teamwork seems incompatible with the Academic Distress Commission and asked whether the current structure allows for team building.
