Mission Statement

The Joint Education Oversight Committee (JEOC) Office will provide information in the form of talking points, resources, updates, newsletters, reviews or briefs to members of the Committee and members of the General Assembly on policy issues about education in Ohio. The JEOC Office is also the research arm of the General Assembly in education; if the desired information is not accessible, the JEOC Office can investigate and research any area of interest to the General Assembly that has been approved by the committee.

The Joint Education Oversight Committee may authorize a plan of work, which will include research, review, study and analysis of current or emerging education policy issues important to the state. The authorized plan of work will include available policy options to address the issues in the research, review, study or analysis. Also, the authorized plan of work will include the available data and research to support the analysis and options put forth.

The committee may prepare a report of its review, research or analysis. A report prepared for the committee by JEOC staff will be voted on by the members and made public after approval by the members. On approved reports, each member has the option to offer an addendum for inclusion in the final report as an appendix to the report.
